Accommodation

Countries need to finalise accommodation requirements and bookings immediately. Accommodation in Warwick is fully booked, so if you haven't paid a deposit and finalised your bookings, we suggest you do. Accommodation houses are receiving new requests daily, so finalise & pay a substantial deposit to avoid disappointment.

If you have supporters looking for accommodation, please refer them to the accommodation section of the website. Currently there are a number of vacancies in nearby villages to Warwick.

Admission to "Morgan Park"

The Official Party (4 Women, 4 Men, 1 Manager, 1 Coach, 1 Umpire & 1 Country President) as per original invitation, will be issued with 12 complimentary weekly Passes which on entry will convert to 12 wristbands to be worn at all times. These passes will be distributed at the Presidents, managers, coaches & captains meeting on Monday 15 April.

<u>Anyone outside of the Official Party will need to purchase an admission pass</u> (either online or at the gate) which will also convert on entry to a wristband be worn at all times.

Official Horse Coordinator

Each country will be assigned an Official Adina Polocrosse World Cup 2019 Horse Coordinator as well as 6 Horse Handlers who will be responsible for the daily care of the horses. A country team member must be accompanied by their OFFICIAL World Cup Country Coordinator when in contact/dealing with horses. Practice Schedule / Rules for Working Horses

Official practice schedule and rules for working horses will be available in the New Year. First Aid will be in attendance at practice sessions.

Horse Services

The Official Vet Services will be supplied by Warwick Vet Clinic (Dr. Chris Reardon). Chiropractic & horse massage services will be available on a user pay basis.

Onsite Team Base

An onsite team base can be made available within the horse area at Morgan Park. This would include a **7.2x3.6m** ground space with marquee to be set-up on Tuesday 16 April at a cost of AU \$143.00 per country. Table & Chairs can also be hired. Bookings are required and must be made by 28 February 2019 (contact: secretary@polocrosseworldcup.com.au).

Storage

Each country will have a feed container which will have limited space available to store team equipment.

Horse Rugs

The World Cup horses will be supplied with **an official lead-out day rug** (sponsored by Australian Stockman's Saddlery) **that is to be worn for the duration of the event**. No other rugs are to be worn during the official lead-out times and no horses are to be paraded with non-official Polocrosse World Cup sponsor branding.

Gear

Teams are required to bring all playing and practice gear. Should you decide not to do this, there will be suppliers onsite, refer to www.australianstockmansaddlery.com.au

Team Sponsorship

A team can only sell sponsorship rights to things that they own. Therefore, you can sell rights to brand exposure on saddles, uniforms, players, etc, but you cannot sell rights to anything that is the property of the Adina Polocrosse World Cup 2019 event such as signage display, PA announcements, horses etc.

Logo use
